- Attended the City Council's Economic Development and Technology (ED Tech)
 Committee meeting on May 21st, along with COO Chris Miller to support the
 PCAC Citizens Advisory Committee (CAC) staying in the Municipal Code. In
 attendance were PCAC Vice President Sally Howell, PCAC Board Treasurer
 Gail Schaper-Gordon and PCAC CAC President Phil Hopkins. Councilmembers
 voted in favor of our request and a date for review by the Mayor and City
 Council forthcoming.
- Pasadena Media, in collaboration with Innovate Pasadena, successfully produced *Innovate Pasadena Presents: Johanna Lucht* (NASA's First Deaf Engineer). It was an all-deaf American Sign Language (ASL) interview and the first production of its kind that Pasadena Media has done. This will air on the Arroyo channel at a later date.
- Attended and televised the 46th Annual Mayor's Interfaith Breakfast at the Pasadena Convention Center. Featured speaker at this event was Dr. Thomas Rosenbaum, President of Caltech and a Professor of Physics who spoke on the subject of "Faith and Science."
- Pasadena Media received a stipend of \$1,500 in partnership with Exploring the Arts (ETA) Spring 2019 Apprenticeship Program.
- Attended the United States Marine Corps (USMC) Welcome Home Ceremony at Pasadena City Hall. These Reserve Marines were returning from their deployment overseas. Many of them are residents in the local areas. Staff provided live coverage for KPAS.
- Pasadena Media covered Councilmember John J. Kennedy's District 3
 Community Meeting held at the Pasadena Presbyterian Church.
- Attended the Police and Fire Memorial 2019 held at Pasadena City Hall. Staff provided live coverage for KPAS.
- Was the Master of Ceremonies at the Kiwanis Annual Student Awards Luncheon held at Pasadena University Club. Awards were given out to deserving students in the Pasadena area.

- Presented overview of Pasadena Media as the guest speaker at the City of Learning (P:CoL) meeting held at Pacific Oaks College.
- Attended as a member of the Pasadena Chamber of Commerce Legislative Committee meeting, reviewing upcoming legislative issues as they relate to the City.
- Met with District Councilmember John J. Kennedy to discuss updates with Pasadena Media and potential candidates for our board from his district.

Operations Report - May 2019

- Post-NAB Trade Show May 8: Attended
 I recently attended Key Code Media's Post-NAB show in Burbank where I spoke with several vendors that I missed at NAB. Among solutions I looked at were SAN/NAS/cloud storage, switchers and ENG cameras.
- ABC7 Tour May 9: Attended Pasadena PIO Lisa Derderian organized a tour of ABC7's facility in Burbank with one of their news directors. Our group, largely comprised of departmental PIOs, got to see one of the largest and busiest affiliate newsrooms in the country up close with opportunities to interact with staff. Most valuable I think was the information regarding how to present information to news directors so that it is noticed amongst the thousands of requests they get each day. My biggest takeaway was just how much the business has changed in the past twenty years in terms of how few people it takes to run an operation of this size. To illustrate: for the live newscast that was going on, there were just six people present: anchor, weather person, stage manager, director, producer and associate producer.
- Granicus Issues: Ongoing
 I continue working with DoIT staff to mitigate issues with their meeting management, streaming and video archival tool. This month, the group took a big step forward by beginning a training program and a plan to clean up the back end to make it easier for future users.
- Council Chamber Security Cameras:
 I've been working with the City Manager's office and DoIT staff to provide guidance on the installation of security cameras to capture activity in the room not caught on our cameras during City Council meetings.
- New Employee Expense Management Tool: Implemented
 We have replaced our Pex debit cards for the staff with Divvy cards. First and
 foremost, this was done to save the \$30/month fee as Divvy is free.
