## **Operations Report**

Prepared by Chris Miller – July 2015 Notable Operations Projects and Their Statuses Conducted During July

- Furnishing / Decorating: Completion By August 7
- New Production Season: Successfully Underway
- City Council Chamber Meeting Management Issues: Ongoing with DoIT Taking the Lead
- Pro Services: Largest Production to Date Successful
- 1. Furnishing / Decorating: Completion By August 7 Our maintenance period in June allowed us to repair and clean up both suites. During July, we utilized the refreshed look of the spaces to complete long-planned furnishing and decorating. Tasks included painting several walls with new accent colors, adding chalkboards in several locations, adding furniture and storage, installing a sleeker front desk area with storage and video monitor, adding art and other decor to various walls, completing A/V wiring in 450 and reorganizing staff offices.
- 2. New Production Season: Successfully Underway Members have returned to production for the new season. The biggest change from last season has been the requirement to find volunteers for crew positions rather than rely on our staff for crew. So far, most productions have been successful with a greater sense of community being created as more members of the public are downstairs when productions are occurring. There have been more cancellations this month than in previous, most of which can be attributed to difficulty recruiting reliable volunteers or failure to complete pre-production. This appears to be lessening as we head into August.
- 3. City Council Chamber Meeting Management Issues: Ongoing with DoIT Taking the Lead During the July 27 City Council meeting, issues with the meeting management equipment led to audio issues inside the chamber. These issues were not experienced outside of the chamber or on KPAS. Testing after the meeting did not reveal the specific cause of the issues, but did provide a temporary fix. DoIT is opening a PO with a vendor to diagnose and repair. The City Clerk's office along with DoIT and Pasadena Media are also working with a company to develop an RFP for a replacement system that is likely to be installed at the end of the year.
- 4. Pro Services: Largest Production to Date Successful Our most ambitious pro services production to date occurred in the studio from July 24-26. We shot a seminar with multiple facets including a live audience and live video streaming over the course of three days. We had an overwhelmingly positive response from the client and our staff. The client expects to utilize our services several more times in the next few months. This event has provided a great deal of information to further develop our policies and procedures for future professional production services.
